Business Meeting:

- Last year's guest speaker was Mark Davidson, Director of Archives and Exhibits /
 Curator of the Bob Dylan Archive from the Woody Guthrie Center / Bob Dylan Center.
 He discussed the creation of the Bob Dylan Center and the archives in particular, which provided a deeper appreciation when we were able to visit the Bob Dylan Center the last night of the conference.
 - o We did a hybrid meeting so that members not able to attend in-person may still attend the business meeting on Zoom. Our treasurer's plans to present via Zoom did not work out but she was glad to be able to attend.
 - o We hope to be able to do this again in Corpus this year.
- Due to the changing schedule, we are not having a guest speaker this year; we will be networking and discussing the dissolution of AAM's PNs and the future of our SPC.
- Inspired by ARCS Giveaway, for new/renewing memberships paid by March 31, 2023, we had a drawing for a copy of the new Museum Registration Methods 6th Edition. Membership Report:
