# State Representatives

State representatives have been extremely valuable partners in assisting with membership drives and relaying RC information to state members. We are currently seeking state representatives for Colorado and Montana. We are also seeking to fill the Development Chair and Nominations Chair positions as well as find Social Media contributors.

# <u>Membership</u>

During the 2022 calendar year, we reported 57 paid members, less than half the previous calendar year. Of those 57 members, 8 were new members and 49 were renewing members. The membership drive began near the end of January. As of February 3rd, we have had 11 members renew their membership. There are several potential new members that have been emailed regarding joining RC-MPMA. Renewal notices will be sent out again at the end of February and March.

#### Behind the Scenes Tour

The BTS tour at the Philbrook Museum of Art (\$10 for RC and another \$10 to the Philbrook for its BTS fee) was limited to 10 people and filled quickly. Due to previous years' misunderstandings and to make things easier on both sides, RC-MPMA is looking to discontinue the \$10 BTS fee. We will however continue sponsoring the BTS tours and promoting RC membership at these events.
